JOB GOAL:

To develop in each student an understanding of the relationship of good body function and exercise; to motivate each student to cultivate physical fitness, hygienic habits, and good social and emotional adjustment; to discover and develop talents of students in physical achievement; to develop strength, skill, agility, poise, and coordination in individual, dual, and team physical activities and sports, in accordance with each student's ability.

- Deep commitment to student effort and achievement by providing an inviting, exciting, innovative, and challenging learning environment.
- Maintains control of storage and use of school-owned property.
- Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior needed to provide an orderly, productive environment in the physical education areas.
- Evaluates each student's growth in physical skills, knowledge, and contribution in team sports.
- Provides appropriate safety instruction and makes safety checks on equipment and field areas to insure the over-all safety of students.
- Inform parent/guardian of child's progress in a timely manner.
- File required reports in an accurate and timely fashion, and maintain pertinent records.
- Effectively organize space, equipment, and students.
- Develop lesson plans that ensure the attainment of grade level state content standards and support project-based learning design.
- Address individual needs of students through short and long term planning.
- Evaluate student's progress on a continuous basis.
- Prepare individual student achievement reports for parents.
- Engage in effective and appropriate classroom management.
- Organize school wide physical activity experiences.
- Collaborate with other staff members to create meaningful community learning opportunities and community-based partnerships and participate in all staff development programs.
- Work with other staff members to form a positive, supportive team atmosphere. Work flexibly with schedules in order to accommodate the varying needs of enrolled students, parents/guardians, and community.
- Perform other duties, as deemed appropriate by the Executive Director and/or the Board.
