Providing ongoing coaching for teachers as well as support with data analysis and the intervention program, these positions will be 100% covered by the grant for the 21-22, 22-23, and 23-24 school years, as follows:

Code 40 Purchased Services	To support the school's assessment and intervention program, ARP-ESSER funds will be used to purchase annual subscriptions for i-Ready (\$28,000/year x 2 years = \$56,000).
	To ensure that a sanitary environment are maintained, the school will use ARP-ESSER funds to cover the cost of supplemental cleaning services (approximately $$1,215/month \ x \ 12 \ months = $14,582$ ).

Ensuring that all students have a laptop to be used both at school and at home will enable us to help address learning loss through the continued use of online curricula and assessments. As the school expands to high school grades over the length of the ESSER grant, Macbooks will be needed to support media arts and other programming implemented as part of the college and career readiness curriculum.
